SCHOOL-PARENT AGREEMENT**



This agreement is made between Az Buki Vedi, Inc, hereinafter named School, and a parent/legal guardian of a child, hereinafter named Caregiver. The conditions of this agreement are observed by both parties.

Dates: Jun 18-22 (age 5-10) Jun 25-29 (age 5-10) Aug 13-17 (age 5-10) Aug 20-24 (age 5-10)

Location: 5078 Park Rd, Ann Arbor, MI 48103

Registration and Program Costs:

1st child: \$20 (\$10.00 before 05/01/2018); next child: \$10.00 (\$5.00 before 05/01/2018)

Week 9:00AM-4:00PM: \$240.00 (\$230.00 before 05/01/2018)

Day 9:00AM-4:00PM: \$60.00

Extended Care/Week 7:30-9:00AM: \$28.00;

Extended Care/Week 4:00-6:00PM: \$30.00

Extended Care/Hour: 5.00

Late Fee: If you are late and pick up your child after the end of the program he/she has been registered for the fee is \$5.00 per each 30 minutes.

Payment: Payment in full or a \$135.00 non-refundable deposit per week is required at the time of registration. Payment in full is due two weeks prior to your child's first day of camp. The School accepts cash and checks (issued to Az Buki Vedi, Inc). A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for returned checks.

Cancellation and Refund Policies: If full payment is not received by the 14-day-prior deadline, your child's registration might be cancelled. Please note: your \$135 deposit is non-refundable. If you choose to cancel 14 days or more prior to your child's program, your payment will be refunded except the \$135 deposit. Cancellation within 13 days of your child's start date will not be refunded. The School reserves the right to cancel the camp if less than five students are registered to participate. In this case, any payment made will be fully reimbursed in ten business days since the day when the decision was made.

Lunch and Snack: Campers need to bring lunches and water bottles. We have microwaves: you are welcome to send food to warm up. Please ensure that any lunches or food items you send with your child are nut-free. We will provide snacks, which will include fruits and crackers.

Personal belongings: The School does not assume responsibility for loss or damage to any personal possessions the child(ren) or the Caregiver brings to the facility.

Medical concerns: For the protection of all children attending the School's Summer Camp program, the Caregiver should keep the child at home if the child shows any of the following symptoms:

- A temperature of over 99 F
- Intestinal disturbance accompanied by diarrhea or vomiting
- Any undiagnosed rash
- Sore or discharging eyes or ears, profuse nasal discharge
- If the child has been exposed to any contagious disease, it should be reported to

the School immediately.
